Responsibilities:

As an intern, you will be an integral part of the JAQET counseling unit, working closely with schools and communities in underdeveloped areas of Islamabad. Your responsibilities will include:

- 1. Conducting Sensitization Sessions with the Community:
 - Engaging with parents to emphasize the significance of girls' education
 - Providing need-based support and guidance to address concerns and challenges
 - Engaging with vocational trainees, guiding them on income-generation paths, and promoting overall social-emotional well-being

2. School Awareness Sessions:

- Raising awareness about crucial topics such as education, child marriage, child abuse, and child protection
- Offering emotional and mental health support to girls, fostering a supportive environment

Requirements:

- Background in psychology (undergraduate, or fresh graduate)
- Fluency in Pushto/Dari required for job interacting with Afghan families
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Passion for community development
- Willingness to visit communities
